STEP 1: Find Ideas (What to Build)

There are 2 ways to find ideas:

Method 1: Find Your Own Ideas

Look for problems around you:

- What takes too much time in your daily life?
- What do local businesses struggle with?
- What tasks are boring and repetitive?

Use Product Hunt website:

1. Go to ProductHunt.com

- 2. Check top products daily
- 3. Find apps that solve real problems
- 4. Think: "How can I make this better?"

Good Ideas for Indian Market:

- WhatsApp automation for small shops
- Restaurant order management
- · Coaching class student tracking
- Real estate lead collection
- Social media post scheduling

Method 2: Find Clients First (SAFER APPROACH)

- 1. Find a business owner with a problem
- 2. Get them to pay you to solve it
- 3. Build the solution for them
- 4. Sell the same solution to other businesses

This is safer because:

- You get paid while learning
- Zero risk of building something nobody wants
- Client becomes your first reference

STEP 2: Build Your Al Agent

- 1. Go to n8n.cloud (free account)
- 2. Create your first workflow
- 3. Connect 2 apps (like Gmail + Google Sheets)
- 4. Test it works
- 5. Show it to potential clients

Wise:

- Growing in popularity
- Lower fees than PayPal
- Faster transfers

Legal Requirements for Indians:

Documents Needed:

- PAN Card (mandatory)
- Aadhaar Card
- Bank account with SWIFT code
- Export license (for income > ₹10 lakh/year)

Tax Information:

- Foreign income is taxable in India
- File ITR-2 form annually
- Keep all payment records
- Consult a CA for proper guidance

3. Poor Communication

- Don't disappear during project
- Explain delays honestly
- Set realistic timelines

4. Underpricing Your Work

- Know your worth
- Factor in support time
- Don't compete only on price

5. Not Having Contracts

- Always have written agreements
- Define scope clearly
- Include payment terms
